一個人的生命得以被轉化,不是一刹那發生的事,而是在上帝的愛及引領中,經過很多人一點一滴耕耘的成果。

窰匠每年都會舉辦大旅行,不但讓中心孩子可以有外出遊歷的機會,更是在活動中讓他們親近上帝。由最初只有部份時段有敬拜、分享及禱告的環節,到今年以退修營形式進行,看到孩子們不再只想著去旅行,而是願意有數天的時間進一步認識及親近上帝,這確實是上帝藉很多同工及短宣隊在他們生命上耕耘的成果。

今年的退修營主題是教導孩子們一顆服侍的心,透過敬拜、 讀經、信息分享、黙想等,讓他們明白服侍上帝的意義。感 恩在獻心會中,他們都表達願意事奉,例如:有孩子表示會 向同學及未信主的人分享福音;有的願意教導中心年紀較小 的孩子洗衫及做功課。他們有這樣的心志,見證了上帝轉化 他們生命的痕跡。 The transformation of a person's life is not an instantaneous event; rather, it is the cumulative result of many individuals nurturing it over time under God's love and guidance.

Every year, Metta organizes a trip for the children at centre, not only providing them with the opportunity to travel, but also bringing them closer to God through different activities. Starting with only parts of the schedule dedicated to worship, sharing, and prayer, this year it has evolved into a retreat format. It is heartening to see that the children are no longer just thinking about traveling, but are willing to spend several days to further understand and draw closer to God. This reflects the fruitful efforts of many co-workers and mission teams in their lives.

This year's retreat theme focused on cultivating a heart of service. Through worship, Bible study, message sharing, and reflection, the children learnt about the significance of serving God. We were appreciated that during the dedication session, they expressed a desire to serve. For example, some children said they would share the gospel with classmates and those who have not yet believed, while others were eager to teach the younger children at the centre how to do laundry and complete their homework. Their willingness to serve is a powerful testament to the signs of God's transformative work in their lives.

上帝奇妙的計劃: 鄉村社區發展中心

God's Wonderful Plan: The Village Community Development Centre

聖經中提及昔日以色列人離開埃及後,神就吩咐摩西興建會 幕,成為神與以色列民同在的象徵及敬拜的地方。神又為此預 備了不同專長的工匠,以及感動百姓願意奉獻各樣興建會幕的 材料,會幕就在眾志成城下,經過約半年的時間完成。

窰匠鄉村社區發展中心的設計也參考了會幕的構思,我們不但 希望藉中心進一步為村民提供不同的服務,更希望中心能成為 村民敬拜上帝的地方,讓他們的生命可以被上帝轉化更新。在 籌備工作中,我們看見上帝為我們預備了不同的弟兄姊妹的參 與,就像昔日祂為會幕所預備的工匠及材料一樣,以下只是其 中的一些點滴。

Mentioned in the Bible, after the Israelites left Egypt, God instructed Moses to build the tabernacle, which became a symbol of God's presence among His people and a place of worship. God also prepared skilled artisans and inspired the people to contribute various materials for the construction of the tabernacle, which was completed in about six months through their united efforts.

The design of Metta's Village Community Development Centre is inspired from the concept of the tabernacle. We hope that the centre will not only provide various services to the villagers but also become a place where they can worship God, allowing their lives to be transformed and renewed by Him. Throughout the preparation process, we have seen how God has brought together different brothers and sisters to participate, just as He provided artisans and materials for the tabernacle in the past. Below are just some of the many contributions.





Concept of the Centre: God's **Tabernacle**

當初我們對於鄉村社區發展中心的設計沒有甚麼特別的想法, 只是從怎樣善用土地、空間,以及切合村民的實用角度出發, 也曾邀請建築及工程界的肢體就設計圖則給予意見,但都未能 落實中心的設計。神的時間是最好的,就在猶豫之際,本身是 建築師的人強弟兄再次與總幹事Almond聯絡,跟進鄉村社區發 展中心的興建進度(他曾於興建中心計劃初期給予專業意見) 他再次協助審視設計圖則。按服務所需,人強弟兄建議以會幕 作為中心的設計藍圖,奇妙地他的構思正正是窰匠的遠景:以 神為中心,神的同在可以轉化人的生命。

Initially, we had no specific ideas for the design of the Village Community Development Centre. Our focus was simply on how to make the best use of the land and space from a practical perspective for the villagers. We even invited members from the architecture and engineering fields to provide feedback on the design plans, but we were unable to finalize the centre's design.


God's timing is always perfect. During this period of hesitation, brother Vickel Liang, who is an architect, reached out to Executive Director, Almond, again to follow up on the construction progress of the Village Community Development Centre (he had previously provided professional advice during the early planning stages). He assisted us in reviewing the design plans once more. Based on the needs of the service, he suggested using the tabernacle as the design blueprint for the centre. Remarkably, his concept aligned perfectly with Metta's vision: to centre on God, allowing His presence to transform lives.











建築細節:專業工匠

Architectural Details: Professional Craftsmen

當中心設計藍圖落實後,下一步就是要仔細審視圖則,看 看中心各項設施規劃及興建要求是否正確。感恩上帝為我 們預備了羅維弟弟兄,他從事建築業已有40年,加上他曾 在柬埔寨參與興建學校的工程,經驗相當豐富。他就與建 築公司的合作、合約細節、工程進度、施工方法、用料等 各方面都能給予我們寶貴的意見。

最初,羅弟兄透過朋友認識案匠,那位朋友當時代表案匠 邀請他參與鄉村社區發展中心興建工程,但因為他對窰匠 缺乏認識,所以便婉拒了。2022年,羅弟兄認識的宣教士 向他介紹了Almond,當進一步了解窰匠鄉村社區發展中心 計劃後,他就決定參與其中。

今次負責鄉村社區發展中心工程的建築設計及興建公司, 恰巧是羅弟兄10年前參與柬埔寨興建學校時已認識的,過 去也有不同的合作,故大家在溝通上不用太多磨合,而且 也是值得信任的。此外,地盤施工需要可靠的人執行施 工過程;羅弟兄曾與建築商的哥哥合作,覺得他是合適人 選、故要求建築商委派他作是次工程的地盤主管。就是這 樣,神使用羅弟兄過去的人脈及經驗,祝福了這項工程。

Once the design blueprint for the centre was finalized, the next step was to carefully review the plans to ensure that the facility's layout and construction requirements were accurate. We are grateful to God for providing Brother Law, who has been in the construction industry for forty years. Having previously participated in school construction projects in Cambodia, he brings a wealth of experience. He offers us valuable insights on various aspects, including collaboration with the construction company, contract details, project timelines, construction methods, and materials.

Initially, Brother Law got to know Metta through a friend who represented Metta and invited him to participate in the construction of the Village Community Development Centre. However, due to his lack of understanding about Metta, he declined. In 2022, a missionary known to Brother Law introduced him to Almond. After learning more about the Village Community Development Centre project, he decided to get involved.

The construction and design company responsible for the Village Community Development Centre project happened to be the same one Brother Law had worked with ten years ago during the school construction in Cambodia. They had various collaborations in the past, which made communication smoother and established a sense of trust. Additionally, reliable individuals are needed to execute the construction process on-site. Brother Law had previously collaborated with the construction manager's brother and felt he was a suitable candidate, so he requested the construction manager to assign him as the site supervisor for this project. In this way, God used Brother Law's past connections and experience to bless this project.

興建費用:甘心奉獻

Construction Costs: Willing Offerings

上帝除了在工程上為我們預備不同專業的義工協助,我們在興建費用上也不斷經歷上帝的預備,當中想分享李梅艷 Melody姊妹的見證。

Melody於2011年確診患癌。2019年,她到窰匠參與短宣服侍,自此對窰匠有更多認識,也認同及欣賞窰匠的使命,就是幫助貧困的村民及家庭、失學兒童及青少年改善生活,分享福音;透過社區服務及心靈關顧,讓村民的生活得到幫助,生命得以轉化。其實,Melody當時正接受口服化療藥治療,藥的副作用令她有時會感到不適,更令她的手甩皮,需要帶手袖或手套保護。縱然有困難,但她仍堅持到柬埔寨服侍。當她得知短宣隊員頭痛、扭傷腳踝,她更主動替她們按摩。短宣期間,她與柬埔寨的孩子玩得很開心,因為她很喜歡小朋友,還曾想到內地服侍孤兒院的小孩呢!

Melody於2024年1月安息主懷,她的摯友Karen(當年與Melody一起參與柬埔寨短宣服侍)替她安排奉獻時,第一個想到的受惠機構就是窰匠,更希望透過誌名奉獻,讓Melody生命的足跡存留在地上。適逢Karen與郭嘉莉醫生(窰匠顧問)閒聊時提及這念頭,郭醫生鼓勵Karen與Almond聯絡,後得知窰匠正為鄉村社區發展中心籌募建築費,並設誌名捐獻,就是這樣Karen安排Melody的奉獻給予窰匠。



In addition to providing us with various skilled volunteers for the project, we have continually experienced God's provision for the construction costs. We would like to share the testimony of Sister Melody Lee.

Melody was diagnosed with cancer in 2011. In 2019, she joined Metta's mission trip, which deepened her understanding of the organization and she appreciated our mission: to help impoverished villagers and families, as well as out-of-school children and youth, improve their lives and share the gospel. Through community service and spiritual care, the goal is to assist villagers and transform their lives.

At that time, Melody was undergoing oral chemotherapy, and the side effects sometimes made her feel unwell, causing her hands to peel so that she had to wear sleeves or gloves for protection. Despite these difficulties, she remained committed to serving in Cambodia. When she learned that some mission team members were suffering from headaches or sprained ankles, she proactively gave them a massage. During the mission trip, she had a wonderful time playing with the children in Cambodia because she loves kids and even thought about serving orphans in mainland China!

Melody passed away peacefully in the Lord's embrace in January 2024. Her close friend Karen, who had served in Cambodia with Melody, immediately thought of Metta as the beneficiary for her memorial donation. Karen hoped that through this donation, Melody's legacy would be preserved on Earth. While chatting with Dr. Ka-li Kwok (the consultant of Metta), Karen mentioned this idea, and Dr. Kwok encouraged her to contact Almond. She later learned that Metta was fundraising for the construction costs of the Village Community Development Centre and had set up a memorial donation program. This is how Karen arranged for Melody's donation to be given to Metta.

The Plan of God

Although we are still fundraising for the costs of furniture and facilities for the centre, we are grateful that the donations received so far are just enough to cover the budgeted construction expenses. We see how God moved the Israelites to contribute to the building of the tabernacle in the past, and we believe He is doing the same today, inspiring brothers and sisters to participate in the construction of Metta's Village Community Development Centre. We need more people to continue engaging in this project so that the centre can become a place where villagers encounter God and experience life transformation.

生命反思 Lives Reflection

有很多身邊的朋友會跟我說:「你存錢又不花,現在不享受你打算等到甚麼時候呢?」

我也會想:「真的!究竟錢花在哪裏才有意義?」

直到上年我在香港基督徒音樂事工聯會(HKACM)見到有一個與客匠合作的柬埔寨短宣活動,作為「信二代」的我,父母當然很想我參加。當我向教會的人分享,他們都認為我這小小年紀能有機會去外地事奉,是一件很感恩的事,但生活在一個有四個小朋友的家庭,作為大家姐的我,擔心爸媽未必能支持我及妹妹去短宣的費用。後來經過祈禱,我們決定邀請身邊的朋友在金錢上支持我們。在上帝的帶領下,我們成功籌得每人港幣8,000元的團費。

短宣期間,我們教當地小朋友英文、樂器、甚至中文,他們 都很快掌握。他們很有天份,只不過是欠缺了一些機會。此 外,探訪鄉村的時候,見到很多家庭住在鐵皮屋裡,也有很 多孩子沒有衣服穿,生活十分刻苦。

上年年底窰匠在香港舉行的籌款音樂會,我可以與柬埔寨的朋友重聚,感覺到大家這份真摯的友情,便與短宣的隊友下定決心儲錢再參與短宣。我不知道有多少人會將這份承諾放在心裡,但我就找到一個有意義的目標去儲錢,更要每日一點一點地實踐大使命:「你們要去,使萬民作我的門徒,奉父、子、聖靈的名給他們施洗,凡我所吩咐你們的,都教訓他們遵守。」(馬太福音28章19-20節上)

儲錢的方法可以很簡單……以前我平均一個星期喝一次珍珠奶茶,為了努力儲錢,我兩、三個月才喝一次。雖然看似容易,但對我來說卻殊不簡單;與朋友逛街,當看見他們買衫、玩具、雪糕等等時,我也擔心自己因為不一起消費而被感到不合群,但當我想起柬埔寨小朋友的生活,又明白自己其實很幸福,就有動力去消除想買非必需品的念頭。

今年能成功儲錢再去柬埔寨,見到中心的孩子真是十分有親切感。雖然一年沒有見面,但我們很快便投入一起分享,互相支持。我們付出的確實很少,卻能參與窰匠改變孩子生命的工作,我們只需要犧牲少少娛樂的花費,買少一樣零食或飲品,無論是30元、50元、100元、或是300元,對窰匠的孩子來說都是一個脫離行乞、可以讀書及改善生活的機會,真是十分有意義。

Realizing the Riches We Have

Many friends often tell me, "You save money but never spend it. When do you plan to enjoy it?" This makes me ponder, "Really! How to spend money in a meaningful way?"

Last year, I came across a mission trip to Cambodia organized by Hong Kong Association of Christian Music Ministry Limited (HKACM) and Metta. As a "second-generation believer," my parents were eager for me to join. When I shared this with people at my church, they felt it was a wonderful opportunity for someone like my age to serve abroad. However, as the eldest sibling in a family with four children, I worried that my parents might struggle to support my sister and me financially for the trip. After praying about it, we decided to reach out to friends for financial support. With God's guidance, we successfully raised HK\$8,000 each for the trip.

During the mission, we taught local children English, musical instruments, and even some Chinese. They quickly grasped the lessons. Actually they are quite talented but just lack of opportunities. Additionally, during our visits to rural areas, I saw many families living in metal shacks and many children without proper clothing, enduring very harsh conditions.

At the end of last year, Metta held a fundraising concert in Hong Kong, where I reunited with friends from Cambodia. I felt the sincerity of our friendship and, along with my mission teammates, decided to save money to participate in another mission trip. I did not know how many people would keep this commitment in their hearts, but I found a meaningful goal for saving. I realized I needed to practice the Great Commission a little bit every day: "Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." (Matthew 28: 19-20a, NIV)

Saving money can be quite simple. In the past, I would have bubble tea once a week, but to save, I now limit myself to once every two or three months. While this might seem easy, it's not simple for me. When I go shopping with friends and see them buying clothes, toys, ice cream, and more, I worry about feeling excluded because I am not spending. However, when I remember the lives of the children in Cambodia, I realize how blessed I am, which motivates me to resist the urge to buy non-essentials.

This year, being able to save money and returned to Cambodia, when I saw the children at the centre, I felt very familiar. Although we had not seen each other for a year, we quickly engaged in sharing and supporting one another. What we contributed was minimal, yet we were able to participate in Metta's work of transforming the lives of these children. We only needed to sacrifice a little entertainment spending, buying one less snack or drink, whether it's HK\$30, HK\$50, HK\$100, or HK\$300, to provide these children with opportunities to escape begging, receive an education, and improve their lives. That is truly meaningful.





五餅二魚的服侍



在聖經福音書中,曾記載耶穌藉一位孩子獻上的五個大麥 餅和兩條魚,行了餵飽五千人的神蹟。侯智強,我們都稱 他「侯生」,在今年的短宣中,再次獻上自己的才幹,用 他的「五餅二魚」,祝福了柬埔寨的孩子及家庭。

侯生與太太去年隨中國基督教播道會泉福堂第一次到柬埔寨短宣,「我甚麼也不曉,最擅長攝影,便想想能否用我的興趣服事人。」他謙虛地說。現時70歲的侯生,退休前是救護員,熱愛攝影。「我相信當地的村民很少機會影相,如果能為他們拍下一些開心片段,打印出來作為留念,那便好了。」就是這個意念,成就了去年服侍的開始。去年,侯生為每位孩子和村民,拍下照片並即時打印出來,放在精美的相框內送給他們,每位收到的朋友都愛不惜手。

「感恩今年我可以再次到訪柬埔寨,我便想可以怎樣改善上次拍攝的服侍。」侯生娓娓道出。今年除了提供精美的相框外,更設過膠服務。「我希望相片過膠後不會因水漬或其他污漬而損毀,可以保存更久。」拍照當日,恰好是其中一家孩子的生日,相信那張照片是孩子及其家人最好的禮物。將來孩子長大了,能看到自己小時候的樣子,對這家人來說很有意義。

「我真是甚麼也不懂,只能透過攝影在短宣中服侍上帝。 除了用心為窰匠中心孩子拍攝外,我也想為村民做點有意 義的事。於是,我想起可以為村民拍照,即時打印相片並 送給他們。讓他們每次看到相片,便記起曾經有一群基督 徒關心他們,與他們分享福音。」就是這樣,侯生在探訪 村民時,就為每位願意拍照的村民,留下聽聞福音的寶貴 時刻。

單純、忠心服侍,就是侯生給我們的印象。在他的心中, 不是要為神作大事,而是忠心獻上自己所擁有的,好像獻 上五餅二魚的孩子一樣,放在神手中,祝福了五千人,而 侯生便祝福了柬埔寨的人民。

The Serving of Five Loaves and Two Fish

In the Gospel of the Bible, it is recorded that Jesus performed the miracle of feeding five thousand people with five loaves and two fish offered by a child. This year, during the mission trip, Mr. Kenny Hou, whom we call "Mr. Hou," once again offered his talents, using his own "five loaves and two fish" to bless the children and families in Cambodia.

Mr. Hou and his wife participated in their first mission trip to Cambodia last year with the E.F.C.C. Spring Church. "I didn't know anything at first; I'm good at photography, so I thought, can I use my hobby to serve others?" he humbly shared. Now 70 years old, Mr. Hou was a paramedic before retirement and has a passion for photography. "I believe the local villagers have very few opportunities to take photos. If I can capture some joyful moments for them and print them out as keepsakes, that would be wonderful." This idea led to the beginning of his service last year. Mr. Hou printed photos on the spot for each child and villager he photographed, placing them in beautiful frames and giving them as gifts. Each person who received one cherished it dearly.

"I am grateful to visit Cambodia again this year, and I wanted to improve upon the photography service from last time," Mr. Hou shared. This year, in addition to providing beautiful frames, he also offered lamination services. "I hope that by laminating the photos, they won't be damaged by water or other stains, allowing them to be preserved for a longer time." On the day of the photo shoot, it happened to be the birthday of one of the children in the family. The photo is surely the best gift for the child and their family, and in the future, when the child grows up, being able to see their younger self will hold great meaning for the family.

"I really don't know much; I can only serve God through photography during the mission trip. Besides carefully photographing the children at Metta's centre, I also wanted to do something meaningful for the villagers. So, I thought of taking photos of the villagers, printing them out on the spot, and giving them the photos. Each time they see the pictures, they will remember that there was a group of Christians who cared for them and shared the gospel with them." In this way, Mr. Hou captured precious moments of hearing gospel for every villager willing to take a photo.

Mr. Hou leaves us with an impression of simplicity and faithful to serve. In his heart, it is not about doing great things for God, but rather about faithfully offer what he has, much like the child who offered the five loaves and two fish, placing it in God's hands to bless five thousand people. In doing so, Mr. Hou has blessed the people of Cambodia.

起初窰匠以服侍柬埔寨金邊街上行乞的孩子為主,現時服務已延伸到干丹省的鄉村;我們服侍的孩子大多來自這條村落。村內貧困家庭眾多,村民及孩子經常以打架、偷竊、賭博、酗酒、吸毒或販毒等問題而臭名昭著,孩子行乞也是其中一種「文化」,窰匠於2016年開始服侍當地村民。今年更會於鄉村裡興建社區中心,為村民提供不同模式的服務,以長遠的方向與及以基督的愛改變該社區,讓村民的生命得以轉化。

Initially, Metta focused on serving the street children begging in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. Now, our services have expanded to the rural village in Kandal Province, where most of the children we serve come from. There are many impoverished families in the village, and the villagers and children are often notorious for problems such as fighting, stealing, gambling, alcohol abuse, drug use, and drug trafficking. Begging has become a part of the "culture" for these children. Metta began serving the villagers in 2016, and this year we will be constructing a community centre in the village. This centre will provide various services to the villagers, aiming to transform the community in the long run through the love of Christ.
